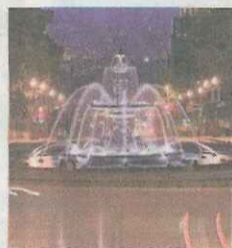

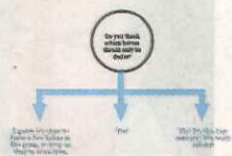

10 best... Floor lamps

Whether you like elegant chrome or beautiful bamboo, we have the leading lights for your home

[1] LINEN FEZ

Looking for a versatile lamp which you can move from room to room as the mood takes you? Check out the linen-shaded fez lamp in light brown, which sits on ash legs. **£385, tmolighting.com**

[2] GIANT ANGLE TASK

Don't let the picture fool you, this purple number is indeed a floor lamp. The oversized desk lamp light is 1.5m high and has a multi-angle arm, which can be tilted in any direction you fancy. **£108.90, debenhams.com**

[3] WALNUT SHADED

The designers at Dwell have come up trumps with this Sixties-inspired lamp, which has three elegant chrome legs and a chic walnut shade. **£129, dwell.co.uk**

[4] GEORGIE

John Lewis sells fantastic lights and the cheap-as-chips Georgie is no exception. The light features a slanted arm body with a suspended cylinder shade in jet black. **£55, johnlewis.com**

[5] BRAVE NEW WORLD

This Moooi lamp is never going to be to everyone's taste but it is certainly pretty special. Inspired by old far Eastern bamboo scaffolding, it is made from lots of small pieces of wood fixed together with rustic-looking clips. **£2331, occa-home.co.uk**

[6] HOLLYWOOD

Get the chrome Hollywood lamp and you will be a third of your way to becoming a star director. Unfortunately, you will have to find the "cameras" and "action" yourself. **£99, marksandspencer.com**

[7] ADRIANA

Is it a lamp? Is it a painter's easel? One thing is for sure, this mango wood floor lamp is a lovely addition to any bedroom or lounge. **£170, johnlewis.com**

[8] FLUORO ORANGE

Tom Dixon created this lamp after seeing builders wearing high visibility jackets, and with its polycarbonate shell painted a bright orange, it is anything but low key. **£435, heals.co.uk**

[9] NOUVEAU

They don't come much brighter - or, dare we say it, brasher - than this ceramic lamp which comes with an oversized cylindrical shade in bright gold. **£99, very.co.uk**

[10] TWIGGY

The tree-branch-like Twigggy does away with the traditional single light format, instead having 12 small inset halogen lights which create a "light cloud", which reflects off its polished chrome surface. **£87, debenhams.com**
